Our unique “cluster” process engages 3-10 congregations of various faith traditions in a one year process that brings “dry bones” child protection practices and policies to life.

It includes:

- 20+ hours of training for a core team
- Interactive child protection policy template
- Two educational presentations for each congregation
- Retreat for adult survivors of child sexual abuse
- Resources for worship and congregational awareness
- Four hour training for all staff and volunteers on mandated reporting, prevention and response
- Prevention curriculums for children and youth
